

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Contrary to recent Media reports, we would like to set the record straight in regard to the Brisbane ANZAC Day March.

- We have **never at any time stated that children cannot march.**
- All veterans (including those riding in jeeps) are entitled to have a carer with them, however that person should be of discretionary age (i.e.: they can assist the veteran if required).
- We **are** trying to discourage the situation where Grandad is marching along with his daughter, her husband and numerous grandchildren.
- The descendant's contingent is to accommodate those descendants where there is no Veteran left to March.
- These decisions are not made by the RSL but by the "ANZAC Day Combined Parade Committee" which is made up of all the units and associations marching. All decisions are made at the organisational meetings of the committee.
- None of the above is in any way different to what has been approved by the committee.
- The **final decision is as it has always been.** It is up to the contingent leader. It is their responsibility to ensure that appropriate dress standards etc are maintained and descendants do not outnumber Veterans.
