- **Disbanded unit association banners are paraded at the head of the march. Any veteran of these units may march behind these leading banners.**
- **Any WW2 veteran from any service or unit may opt to march behind the leading banners.**
- **March six abreast.**
- **Veterans must march the full distance or ride in a wheelchair, jeep or golf car.**
- **Next-of-Kin (NOK) representation is restricted to one per veteran and that representative must wear that veteran's full-sized medals on the right breast.**
- **A child representing a veteran is to be of a discretionary age.**
- **NOK are to march to the rear of and separate from unit veteran contingents.**
- **Attire should be neat and tidy - no torn denim, sporting attire, dirty joggers or quasi military uniforms.**
- **No pictures are to be carried.**
- **Children are not to be carried or pushed in prams.**
- **No animals are allowed other than police, light horse and war dog contingents.**
- **This is a march of honour—keep in step.**
